Choose the right type. If portability is a priority, buy the size that best fits your needs.

For a better picture quality, consider a compact size that would also provide more control over the image and photographs with a highest level registering images (measured in mega pixels).

Recognize the characteristics that meet your needs.

There are many cameras with useful features but not essential for you. Depending on what is most important or not: large liquid crystal displays (LCD), ability to offer a slide show, video recording and other programs directly incorporated into the camera.

If control of the image is a priority, look for a compact camera with manual controls for greater control.

Consider the design. The appearance and tactile nature of the camera are important factors. Some cameras are better suited to different types of hands and type of use.
